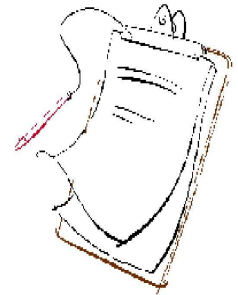


## Events

## Camp Cards

- Would you like to send your scouts to Scout Day Camp or the longer Adventure Camp this summer? Now, how would you like to do it if it were free? **Yes, FREE!!!**
- All it takes is for your scout to sell 15 camp cards at \$10 each for Day Camp, or 20 cards for Adventure Camp. These cards will sell themselves when your scout tells people he "**is trying to earn his own way to scout camp and only has to sell 20 of the cards.**" There are some very good discounts on these cards and they will sell (**much better than popcorn by the way**). The greatest thing about these cards, besides the offers, is that your scout gets back \$4 from each card that he sells. That is where Every Scout in Camp comes into play.
