

How to join Scouts.

Look for flyer in your child's take home folder.

Come to a meeting for new scouts.

Complete registration information.

Cubs are formed into their new Dens. Den leaders and Assistant Den leaders are assigned to each new Den.

What is the cost?

- **Council Fee: \$20-\$25** (non-refundable). Payable at meeting.
- **Pack Fee: \$60.00** (includes payment for all awards earned through the year and Den dues).
- **Uniform: \$40.00- \$60.00** (Hat, shirt, neck-chief, belt, slide, and patches).
- **T-Shirt (Class-B Uniform) \$10**
- **Handbook \$8** (optional)

Fundraising pays for the bulk of pack activities and can also pay for your Scout's fees.

Who is Cub Scouts for?

Cub Scouts is for boys in 1st grade to 5th grade.

How does Cub Scouts work?

Cubs are assigned to Dens based on their grade level.

Each Den contains 7-10 boys, a Den leader, and Assistant Den leader.

Usually, Dens meet twice a month and take field trips.

Each year Cubs complete activities towards earning their rank (badge).

Tigers – 1st grade



Wolves – 2nd grade



Bears – 3rd grade



Webelos I – 4th grade



Webelos II – 5th grade

Each rank teaches the Cubs to do their best. Webelos II prepares Cubs for Boy Scouts.

In addition to earning their rank, Cubs can earn belt loops and pins for academic and sporting achievement.

Every month Dens come together as a Pack for fun, skits, and awards.
